Conduct and audit of all available ICT provision on the site to determine the current state of ICT. This includes ICT back bone equipment, internet, laptops and desktops. B. Discuss with the Finance Committee and Governing Council the need for longer term planning with built in sustainability. C. Prepare options for moving forward to present to Governing Council. D. Survey staff to determine what equipment is in use and what equipment is restricting student access.
	<p>Outcome 2: To investigate issues associated with Open Access and Distance Education delivery</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Determine issues with Open Access hard and software provision. (ie CAD drawing software at Year 11 and 12) B. Attempt to find solutions to get around the issues presented by Open Access using software in compatible with the Edu Connect environment. C. Escalating the issues with DECD ICT help desk in an effort to have a DECD solution. D. Ensure that school based hardware is capable of meeting student needs in the dedicated Open Access pod.

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Outcome 3:

To develop a 5 Year Plan for ICT equipment purchase with built in redundancy scheme to ensure that our equipment is no more that 4-5 years old at any given time.

Outcome 4:

To trial digital based approaches to tracking attendance (Daymap) and looking at how parents and students can access curriculum information remotely.

- A. To identify the most urgent student needs and to build Year 1 of the plan around redressing this situation. To advise Finance and GC and to seek funds to undertake the purchases for Year 1 of the Plan.
 - B. Investigate the best value for money from DECD approved suppliers of hardware. (Dell and HP)
 - C. To plan out a replacement / renewal plan for the 4 remaining years of the sustainability plan
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- A. Conduct a trial of Daymap (subscription purchased in 2015 and moved into 2017) based around tracking attendance for designated groups across the school.
 - B. Ensure that teachers of the designated groups have hardware that can allow the trial to proceed.
 - C. Explore how curriculum and assessment requirements can be available to parents and students remotely. Use a target group to trial this approach.

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Outcome 5:

To explore ways in which students can improve their learning opportunities using the ICT provision that the school has.

- A. Research what hard and software is being used to improve student learning via contact with other schools, articles based around learning techniques, and commercial applications.
- B. Provide advice for the 5 Year plan as to what direction the school needs to be going for future purchases.
- C. Explore the value and role of BYOD and how it could apply to JCS
